- 005/19 To co-opt the new Parish Councillor for Plungar – Malcolm Grant was proposed by Councillor Parry and seconded by Councillor Lowther. Mr Grant accepted the position of Parish Councillor for Plungar and was welcomed by all to the Parish Council.
