164/18 Apologies for absence – Apologies received from Councillors Lowther and Jackson together with apologies from Pam Baguley

Applications received for consideration –

(a) 18/01150/FUL – Redmile Church of England Primary School – there were no objections to this application

(b) 19/00225/FUL – Paddock Land, Barkestone Lane, Plungar – Councillor Parry advised that there were currently 131 comments on the MBC website relating to this application. He asked if any members of the public, in attendance, wished to speak in favour of this application. Both the applicant and his wife spoke at the meeting.

Councillors had read the draft response circulated to them on 14th April 2019 and this was read out at the meeting. There were a couple of suggested amendments from the public and the Parish Council emphasised that it was very important that they referred to the Melton Local Plan. The Parish Council would ‘tidy up’ their response to this application and submit to MBC where it would be available for parishioners to read on line. The Parish Council agreed, unanimously, to object to this application.

(c) 19/00286/OUT – Land off Granby Lane, Plungar – Councillors had read the draft response of suggested comments circulated to them on 14th April 2019 and this was read out at the meeting. It was agreed that a copy of the letter and survey sent to Plungar residents from Midlands Rural Housing together with the Parish Council’s letter to Jim Worley in response to the survey would accompany the Parish Council’s response to this application.

The Parish Council would ‘tidy up’ their response on this application and submit to MBC where it would be available for parishioners to read on line. The Parish Council agreed, unanimously, to object to this application.
